# **Expectations of Teams playing in NVTBL**

# **NVTBL Rules of Engagement**

- Pay attention during the scheduling process—let us know ASAP if you see a major problem.
- Background Checks please make sure every adult who will be assisting with team management and working with players has undergone a background check annually.
  - Recommend USA Baseball
- Enter 3 contacts (name, email address & phone #) to Team Information.
- Always have a printed copy of the Team Contacts with you at the field.
- Always have a printed copy of the baseball field care for the field where you are playing/practicing with you at the field.
- Call your opponent two (2) days prior to EVERY scheduled game. Many games scheduled at 13u and up are on neutral fields.
- Bring an NVTBL Rules sheet to every plate meeting (found under HANDOUTS)
- Don't get tossed from a game—You'll be suspended for 8 days!
- Be nice to NVTBL staff and they will be nice to you!



# 12U Teams Moving up to 13U – What to Expect

#### 13U FIELDS

- •Fields are NOT prepped by Fairfax county
- •Teams CANNOT work fields that have mud or standing water-No Turface!
- •Remember to review the field info for fields—PRIOR to your game to learn about pre- and post field care, as well as how to turn lights on and off and how to access locks if keys are needed for lights or gate entry.
- •Most games are played on neutral field sites (county fields)--there is not usually a game host unless its a private field. BOTH teams are expected to share in pre- and post game field care.

#### **UMPIRES**

- •Number: 2 umpires for 13U and up games.
- •Cost per umpire: \$95 per game—split between the teams—each team will pay for one umpire OR if there is only one umpire, the fee for a solo umpire is roughly 1 ½ times the cost of one umpire due to the difficulty in covering a big field with a solo umpire
- •Payment: Umpire charges will show up in your accounting tab. You will get emails after each game asking you to score the game and pay the amount due.
- •Contacting Umpires: At 13U and up there is no need to confirm umpires. NVTBL uses an umpire assigning organization, MAC Umpires.
- •Coaches are still responsible for contacting the umpire if their game needs to cancel etc.

#### **GAMES PLAYED**

- •13U Weekend DH games can be played on Saturday OR Sunday
- •13U teams can play a single game during the week
- •13U Teams can play single or DH games—(unique opponents will still depend on how many other teams are requesting single games within your age and competition level)
- •When you fill out your availability for games, be sure to include in your scheduling notes what your team is looking to play each week: For example: weeknight game on tues/wed/thurs and then a DH game on Sundays.

#### **NVTBL** Tournaments

- •NVTBL does not host a 13U and up End of Season (EOS) tournament.
- •NVTBL does offer tournaments each season through the ATBA: DMV Tournaments ATBA (atballiance.org)




# **Scheduling**

We have scheduled the first 2 to 3 weeks depending on your level based on the available dates you entered.

#### To View Your Schedule

Login to the site – nvtbl.org

Click on the words EVENTS CALENDAR (NOTE: If you are associated with more than 1 team, you'll see the schedules for all teams.)




You will see your game calendar






## **Schedule**

To see details and/or score the game, click on any of the wording for that game.



A pop up window will appear with the details for that game.



You can view the Field info, see the umpire assigned, and score the game. If the umpire is not showing up, you may need to go back to the old site to view the assigning organization.


To score the game, click in the grey box and enter the score. You will be able to indicate the # of umpires that showed up or that NVTBL assigned.


Hit DONE when finished.



## **Schedule**

You can also go directly to the OLD SITE to view your schedules in a different format. Login (nvtbl.org) and go to COACHES CORNER. Next, select OLD SITE SCHEDULE PAGE. If you need general info in the OLD SITE, you can also select that from the same side bar pop up. You will need to select your team name to enter the old site.







## **Schedule**

You will receive an email with your schedules through the date we've scheduled thus far. Look at everything closely – including your Availability Calendar.

We understand changes will happen, but we work very hard to create your schedule.

To have you register for a tournament or forget that you can't play on a particular date due to holidays, school events, etc. causes us lots of work to undo your schedule, not to mention the impact on your opponent.




#### **Rosters**

To enter your team's roster on our site

Login – nvtbl.org

Go to the 3 horizontal lines and choose PLAYER REGISTRATION

You will be taken to the old site and you may need to enter your old login/password (a 3 or 4 digit code or for new teams, or admXXXX – contact your scheduler if you do not have the old login info)



#### Go to TEAM ADMINISTRATION – TEAM ROSTER



For 8u – 12u, rosters must be capped at 20 players and each player must register via the NVTBL.org web-site. Rosters can be amended; however, no changes may take place after October 10th (fall season) and May 10th (spring season) unless approved by the scheduler.

There is no restriction as to the number of players on a 13U+ roster. Players can be added/deleted at any time during the season – just remember that players are not covered by NVTBL insurance if their complete information is not entered into your team roster on the website.



#### Rosters – NEW INFO

You can now delete and/or add new players to your roster.

Once the new site is ready for rosters, this info will be transferred over. NOTE: You can view your players on the new site, but the most up to date info is still on the old site.

You will notice that you need more information than before – it is a new requirement from the county. NOTE: For Fairfax County based teams, you will be charged a fee of \$50 per player for all athletes who do not live in Fairfax County (including Arlington County, Falls Church 22046, and City of Alexandria 22302, 22304, 22314).

Hit the SAVE button when you are finished.

#### **Rosters**

NOTE: NVTBL allows teams at 13u and up to have 40% of the team one age older. Example: If your team is 13u, 60% of the team must be league age 13u, while 40% of the team can be league age 14u.

#### **Player Movement Policy**

Travel team players should expect to be fully committed to their team for the duration of the season (i.e. Spring/Summer or Fall). Coaches are not permitted to recruit players during the season (i.e. Spring/Summer or Fall). Once the season has concluded, players are able to tryout for a different team. If a player requests a change in team during the season, they must obtain a release from the head coach. If the coach approves the release, he/she should email NVTBL with the player's name and the reason for the release. If the coach does not approve the release, that player is not eligible to play for a new team for that season.



## **Parent Consent Forms & Waivers**

Your team has been assigned a unique 3 or 4 digit login & password for your parents. They can sign the waivers and view the team schedules with this code.




NOTE: You need to have entered the roster before the parents can sign the forms & waivers.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR HOW TO LOGIN AS A PARENT AND COMPLETE FORMS & WAIVERS

Give the parent the 3 or 4 digit code and send them to – <a href="https://www.nvtbl.org">www.nvtbl.org</a> to login. They will go to the right hand side of the site and select PARENT/PLAYER LOGIN.

They will then be directed to the old site where they will enter the 3 or 4 digit code you gave them.








# **Parent Consent Forms & Waivers**

They will then be asked to choose their child from one of two areas. If they are new to your team, they will choose the top NEW PLAYER section.

# **Scheduling Notes**

If you are available, you will play!

NVTBL is a travel program – you should plan on traveling.


8U – 12U should expect to play one out-of-conference game. Expect each team to host a 3-way DH each season, and to play several stacked DH's. The games slots are set up to maximize field use and umpire availability as well.

Scheduling Preferences are used by the NVTBL game schedulers to better understand your team's needs. NOTE: NVTBL makes NO guarantee that your preferences will be met. Preferences are just that: a "preference".

13u and older teams – most fields are neutral fields. Coaches will need to coordinate who can go to check playability of fields that are neutral.

**To change your dates of availability** – NOTE: You can no longer adjust March and April. May can be changed until 3/20 and June can be changed until 4/25.

Login (nvtbl.org) and go to MY TEAM button





# **Availability Calendar**

On the team's page, click the "Registration" tab and click the "View" button on the current season's registration:

To view/adjust your Schedule Preferences (dates you are available) – click on the dark blue SCHEDULE PREFERENCES button. Scroll down to Availability section and click on the button ADD AVAILABILITY DATES.


A popup window will appear that shows you the months. NOTE: dates are blocked from being updated when NVTBL is actively scheduling games. If you need to adjust any dates during this period, contact your scheduler. Dates that are DARK BLUE are unavailable, WHITE dates mean your team is available to play a game.


The month defaults to DARK BLUE so you will need to click on all dates you are available to play a game.

#### **Tournaments and Events**

**COI**—NVTBL is able to provide Certificate of Insurance to all teams that are insured through NVTBL. Please contact Lisa (<a href="mailto:admin@nvtbl.org">admin@nvtbl.org</a>) at least 5 days prior to your tournament. Please include tournament name, address, and dates.

**Hosting for an NVTBL Tournament**—Your scheduler will occasionally ask if teams are interested/able to host. Teams will be compensated for their time and resources for bracket play games. Specific details/amounts will be provided by your scheduler.

**NVTBL Clinics/Camps**—Every season NVTBL hosts events for players to improve their skills and to be measured on skill improvement. These events are posted on the NVTBL website and broadcast via email. Many of the events are fee based, specific details are provided for each event.



# Miscellaneous

Players on waivers—Age(s), Grade Levels & Teams Playing Up/Down: In short, we believe in doing what is best for the competitive development of players and to this extent we provide waivers for teams that would like to play up in age divisions or even individual players who may need to play DOWN in age division. You must discuss your specific circumstances with a league administrator for more information. NOTE: For 8U – 14U, many tournaments require players to be their age level in order to participate in any tournament games.

**Practices**—NVTBL schedules one weekly reoccurring practice for Fairfax County based teams. An email has been sent to eligible (non-league based) teams to explain the procedure for requesting the reoccurring practice for the season. Teams may also request a second practice based on field availability with 7 days notice.

Login – go to 3 horizontal lines and choose TEAM LISTINGS Go to

**COACHES CORNER** 

Next choose – TEAM CONTACTS

Select your team and choose USERS/STAFF.

If the user has accepted their invite and completed their profile, there will now be a simple green checkmark on the user.

Users that have not accepted their invitation will still be marked with an "Invite Sent" status.

If you need to resend the invite, there is an option for that

**To invite a user** — click on the "INVITE USER" button. When selecting a role for the contact, here is a brief explanation —

Enter their email address and choose the role they will play on your team

FRANCHISE OWNER – individual who controls multiple teams and manages accounting for these teams TEAM OWNER – individual who controls the finances for a single team

TEAM ADMINISTRATOR – usually a head coach ASSISTANT COACH – an assistant coach for the team




# **Update Team Contacts**

NOTE: It may take up to a minute for your teams to populate – give it some time.









# **REQUESTS – Practice, Game or General**

**PRACTICE REQUESTS** – for Fairfax County based teams only. 8U - 12U teams using Fairfax practices will be charged an additional \$75 to pay the athlete user fee charged to NVTBL by the county. An email has been sent to all Fairfax based teams asking for 3 choices for fields, dates and times. A practice time will be given on a weekly basis. If you need a second practice slot, please use this system.



# **REQUESTS – Practice, Game or General**

**VIEW GAME REQUESTS** – this will take you to the old site where you can view the Game Requests that other teams have entered. If one of the requests meets your need, click on the "I'll Take It" button.



**GAME REQUESTS** – If you would like to put in a Game Request for additional games, please use this system. For example, if you registered for a tournament and it was canceled and your team is now available to play – go in and enter a game request. Fill in the info requested. If a team accepts your game request, your scheduler will schedule the game.

**GENERAL REQUESTS** – If you have a general question (game change, accounting question, website question, insurance question, etc., please use this system. NOTE: If you are looking for an insurance COI, please allow 5 days and provide the name of the tournament and the address.





# **Pregame Procedures**

- •Within 2 days of each scheduled game Check your game schedule on the NVTBL website to make sure no changes have been made to the game, opponent, field or time. <u>SCHEDULES</u>
- •Contact your opposing coach two days in advance of each scheduled game to confirm the date, location and time of the upcoming game.
- •Agree on which of you will check the field to make sure that it is playable, how will you take care of the field, etc.
- •Make sure that you have each other's cell phone numbers.
- •Teams 8u-12u Hosting team needs to confirm the umpire.

#### Weather-related cancellation/change procedure - NVTBL Weather Hotline

- Check the field to confirm it is unplayable—often this means driving to the field.
- Contact your opponent to let them know.
- Check your schedule to see which umpire is listed for your game and call the umpire listed for your game (will either be an individual listed or an association) and cancel the game. NOTE: Games canceled more than 3 hours in advance no charge. Games canceled less than 3 hours charge is ½ game fee. NOTE: If the umpire has not left for the game and can be reached, there is no charge.
- If the field is not playable, call the umpires as early as you can to cancel your game. Do not send an email! Do not TEXT.
- The telephone numbers for the umpires are listed next to your game under the SCHEDULES tab on the website.
- Update the website. Click on 'Schedules' button & bring up your team's schedule. "Score" the game as a rainout.
- If the field is "open" but the field is not playable, don't play!
- Do not call the umpires to ask whether your field is open -- they do not check field conditions.
- Fields are allocated to us by different jurisdictions and our field allocation depends upon our treating these fields with respect.
- Damaging a field is a good way to get kicked off the field. Do not play on the field if the field is unplayable. Fairfax County Park Authority Fields provides a weekday update after 3pm, <u>Fairfax County Park Authority Field Status</u> or Call the Fairfax County Park Authority Inclement Weather Hotline#: FCPA 703-324-5264 (Mon-Fri after 3:00 p.m.)

#### • Not enough players, date change, time change, etc.

- If it is 24 hours or less from your game time, you need to call the umpire listed for your game. You will be responsible for game fees.
- If it is more than 24 hours from your game time, call your scheduler and see if we can find a team to take your place. **NOTE: You will be responsible for game fees if we cannot find someone**



# **Day of Game**

## Arrival at Fields—

Many fields will have multiple games scheduled back-to-back, keep that in mind when arriving prior to your game.

Note: Loudoun county HS fields only allow 60 min pregame warm up

**Plate Meeting**—introduce yourself to your opponent and the umpire, agree upon the rules for the game—bring rule sheet with you, agree on official start time and end time

# **During Game: Code of Conduct**

NVTBL has a code of conduct for Coach's, players and Parents. Every season, NVTBL requires coach's, players and parents to follow the code of conduct.

# **Day of Game—Post Game Procedures**

#### Field care -

BOTH teams are responsible for helping with pre- and post-game field care. Before your game, review the field care information for your scheduled game here: NVTBL Field Instructions. You will need to login with your Coach login and password to view this information. Do not assume that you should leave a tarp off if you don't see one on when you arrive – read the Field Instructions. Bring a rake to games, some fields do not have rakes on site, you'll need the rake to fill holes and to get the mound and home plate ready for the game.

## Leaving the dugout—

Pick up all trash and throw it away. Remove your equipment and leave the dugout in a timely manner, especially if a team is scheduled after you—you may host your team meeting outside the dugout.

# Posting scores—

- Log into the NVTBL website (www.nvtbl.org). Click on CALENDAR.
- Click on the game you wish to score and click in the grey box and enter the score.
- Click on DONE when finished.

## Weekend Calls to NVTBL Staff

## **Weather Procedures**

- Most games on neutral fields, contact opponent to determine which coach/team will check the field. Check the field to confirm it is unplayable - often this means driving to the field.
- Contact your opponent to let them know.
- Check your schedule to see which umpire is listed for your game and call the umpire listed for your game (will either be an individual listed or an association) and cancel the game. NOTE:
   Games canceled more than 3 hours in advance no charge. Games canceled less than 3 hours charge is ½ game fee. NOTE: If the umpire has not left for the game and can be reached, there is no charge.
- If the field is not playable, call the umpires as early as you can to cancel your game. Do not send an email! Do not TEXT.
- Update nvtbl.org. Click on 'Schedules' button & bring up your team's schedule. "Score" the game as a rainout.
- If the field is "open" but the field is not playable, don't play! 13u and up fields CANNOT be worked, you are not allowed to add turface or rake mud into the grass!
- Do not call the umpires to ask whether your field is open -- they do not check field conditions.
