

West Potomac Baseball Field Care

- Do not play on the field if there is standing water anywhere in the infield
- Do not remove wet dirt from the mound or anywhere in the infield.
- Please do all warm up exercises in the outfield and not on the infield grass.
- Please stay off the foul lines when warming up. Cleats will destroy the grass and foul lines.
- If you use the field for batting practice, put a field screen behind the batter if you are not using a catcher
- Do not use any part of the fence for pepper or to throw against.
- POST GAME MAINTENANCE (tools are in the Conex box):
 - Rake and level the ENTIRE infield, not just around home plate and the bases. Fill and tamp holes at home plate, the pitcher's mound and around the bases.
 - DO NOT rake dirt into the grass. Rake it parallel to, or away from, the grass.
 - Remove all trash and litter from the dugouts. Place it in the trash cans or take it with you
 - Remove any other trash you see or brought with you – leave the field in better condition than you found it.
 - If you are the last team to use the field, cover the mound and home plate with tarps – After raking!
- Turn off field lights (after the last game played)
- Notify your league commissioner immediately if you have any problems.

Please remember that failure to properly take care of this field can result in the loss of the field for future use by your team and your league. Help keep this facility in good shape for all users.
